**Subject- For the purpose of Section 18 of Right to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009, in correspondence with Rule 11 and sub rule(4) of Right to Free and Compulsory Education Rule, 2011 granting permission certificates to school.**

Hon'ble Sir/Madam

Regarding the issue of accreditation certificate to the affiliated schools, on the basis of your blind reference dated 22/04/2022 and subsequent correspondence with the school in this regard Sangli for a period of three years from **01/04/2022 to 31/03/2025**. For 1st to 8th **Rajeev Kore Bright Future Public School, Sangli, Tal. Miraj-Dist. Sangli** is giving temporary recognition to this school.

**The above accreditation is subject to the fulfillment of the following clause:**

1. The accreditation period will not be extended and there will be no obligation under any circumstances to grant accreditation after Class VIII.
2. Pursuant to the provisions of the Free and Compulsory Education to Parents 2009 (Annexure One) and the Right to Free and Compulsory Education to Children of Maharashtra Rules, 2011 (Annexure Two).
3. School will give admission to the children belonging to the weaker section and bound group near school, in the first class, up to a limit of at least 25% of the number of students in that class and will give them free and compulsory education till the completion of primary education. In the case of compliance with this standard even in the case of pre primary classes.
4. A separate bank account shall be provided to the school for the child specified in paragraph 3 to be reimbursed as per Section 12(2) of the Schools Act.
5. The institution/school will not charge any capitation fee and will not force her parents to take any action.
6. No child can be denied admission in a school due to lack of proof of religion, caste, creed, birth place or any other reason..
- 7.(1) Any child admitted to the school will not be detained in the same class as he/she will be.  
(2) No driver shall be subjected to corporal punishment or mental harassment.  
(3) No child will be required to pass a board examination until completion of primary education.  
(4) Every child who has completed primary education will be given a certificate prescribed under Rule 23.  
(5) Students with disabilities will be included as per the provisions of the Act.  
(6) The teachers who have the minimum qualification prescribed under Section 23 (1) of the (Maha) Act will be appointed. And the teachers who do not hold such minimum qualification will have to modify such minimum qualification within a period of five years.  
(7) The teacher shall perform his/her duties as per Section 24 (1) of the Act.  
(8) The school will ensure that the teacher does not engage in private tutoring. However, the minimum qualification on the commencement date of the Act..
8. The school shall follow the syllabus prepared on the basis of the syllabus prescribed by the authority.
9. The school shall admit students as compared to the facilities available in the school as prescribed in section 19 of the Act.



10. The school shall comply with the standards and norms specified in section 19 of the Act. The facilities available at the the school at the time of the previous inspection were as follows

11. Unauthorized classes or classes may not be conducted on or off the premises in the name of the school.

12. The school building or other construction or playground may be used for educational or skill development purposes only.

13. The school is being run by an organization registered under the Society Registration Act, 1860 (21 of 1860) or the Mumbai Public Trust Act, 1950. 14. The school is not run for the benefit of any person, group or individual or any other person or for any profit.

15. The school accounts should be audited and certified by Chartered Accountant and appropriate account statements should be prepared as per the rules. A copy of each article statement should be sent to the District Education Officer every year.

16. The accreditation code your school received is **UDISE NO 27351002111**

It should be noted in any correspondence with this office.

17. The school should submit the report and information as requested by the teacher director/ district education officer from time to time or follow the instructions given by the government of local authority to continuously fulfill the condition of school accreditation or to rectify the errors in the functioning of the school.

18. If there is any registration of the organization, it should be renewed. 1. Other conditions are attached herewith as per "Three".
